CARE & FAIRs philosophy is based on the belief that this objective is reachable with the adequate help, basically involving two important areas – education and health. Massimo collaborates with CARE & FAIR and guarantees that no child labour is employed in the production of its rugs. Our production in India is SA 8000 certified.

#### **SMETA**

(Sedex Members Ethical Trade Audit) is one of the most widely used ethical audit formats in the world. It provides a globally-recognized way to assess responsible supply chain activities, including labor standards, health and safety, the environment, and business ethics. SMETA's methodology is underpinned by the Ethical Trading Initiative Base Code and local law, ensuring comprehensive and robust audits that are respected across industries.

#### **GLOBAL RECYCLED STANDARD**

(GRS) is a product standard for tracking and verifying the content of recycled materials in a final product. The standard applies to the full supply chain and addresses traceability, environmental principles, social requirements, chemical content and labeling. GRS covers processing, manufacturing, packaging, labeling, trading and distribution of all products made with a minimum of 20% recycled material.

#### **SA 8000**

International certification standard that encourages organizations to develop, maintain and apply socially acceptable practices in the workplace. Since its creation in 1989, the Social Accountability International (SAI) organization, an affiliate of the Council on Economic Priorities, is viewed as the most globally accepted independent workplace standard. SA8000 certification addresses issues including forced and child labor, occupational health and safety, freedom of association and collective bargaining, discrimination, disciplinary practices, working hours, compensation, and management systems.

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#### Standard for the Surface Flammability of Carpets and Rugs

The "Standard for the Surface Flammability of Carpets and Rugs" is a critical safety regulation that addresses the fire resistance of carpeting materials. Commonly cited as FF 1-70 or FF 2-70, these are federal flammability standards set to minimize the risks associated with the ignition and spread of fire in carpets and rugs.

#### Colorfastness to light Standard: ISO 105-B02grade 5

ISO 105-B02:2014 specifies a method intended for determining the effect on the colour of textiles of all kinds and in all forms to the action of an artificial light source representative of natural daylight (D65). The method is also applicable to white (bleached or optically brightened) textiles.

#### SA8000 Standard Production

The SA8000 Standard and Certification System provide a framework for organizations of all types, in any industry, and in any country to conduct business in a way that is fair and decent for workers and to demonstrate their adherence to the highest social standards. Created by SAI in 1997 as the first credible social certification, it has led the industry for over 20 years.
